

Congregational Care



How we use your donations to live out the commandments of Jesus, the mission of Hillside, and the responsibilities outlined in Hillside's Standard of Procedure:

- Coordinate with the pastor and/or Clerk of Session to provide care for persons in the congregation with special pastoral needs
- Assist in ministering to members by sending cards, making telephone calls, sending "Thinking of You" cards, visiting sick and shut-ins, recording attendance
- Use attendance records for visitor and member follow-up
- Stock and inventory materials and supplies needed for church activities such as After Church Refreshments, dinners, receptions, etc.
- Plan, schedule and implement member and visitor functions such as luncheons, Christmas Dinner, Church picnic
- Assist with and coordinate receptions for funerals or memorial services as requested
- Encourage participation in Nurture Groups
- Work with Evangelism to welcome new members into the life of the church by hosting new member receptions and assigning new members to Nurture Groups

The Social Mission Ministry supports local mission work in its community. Hillside members believe that helping others is a way of showing our love for humankind. One project is the Food Pantry. It supplies food for many families in the neighborhood. The members and volunteers spend many hours working to help support the pantry. A Health Fair and Fall Festival are planned which will benefit the neighborhood and the community. The Mission Ministry also gives school supplies to Snapfinger Elementary School and gives support to Hagar’s House for families who do not have a place to live temporarily. The Ministry also supports the Georgia Justice Project. It gives transportation to families who visit their love ones who are incarcerated in different places in the state. It is a part of Presbyterians for a Better Georgia which is an advocacy organization for the Presbyterian church U. S. A. It also gives to the Marie Fearing Foundation and Black Presbyterian Caucus.

Finally, Hillside supports the Hunger Walk which benefits the Food Bank for metropolitan Atlanta.

Worship



The purpose of the Worship Ministry is to use the many gifts and talents of its members to plan and prepare the Sunday service so that the congregation may be led to praise and worship God. The service overall should highlight connections between worship, Christian life, witness, and service.

The music director in consultation with the Pastor, selects hymns, spirituals and other forms of congregational song, accompanied by an array of instruments.

The Worship Ministry is responsible for communion services, to include serving shut in members/friends of Hillside. This shall include the preparation of the elements and the enlistment and training of elders for serving the sacrament.

Due to Covid-19 the congregation is unable to meet in person, the Worship Ministry will plan and prepare a virtual service with the use of prerecorded or live footage shared via Facebook or other social media platforms.

- Compensating guest musicians and ministers
- Reimbursements of expenses of volunteers
- Maintenance of organ/piano twice a year (when needed)
- Maintenance of Bell/Chimes
- One license for Streaming/podcast (projecting/reprinting music)
- Flowers and other Worship supplies

Christian Education Ministry goal is to nurture and guide the youth towards an understanding that God is at the center of every pursuit of Christian knowledge. CEM use Christian Educational Publications as a guide for teaching the youth and adult church school classes.

CEM works with other ministries by providing spiritual instructions to perform functions such as welcoming new members, gifts for high school graduates, food and refreshments, attendance incentives, and back to school supplies. A Zoom account was purchased to virtual assist leaders in continuing to virtually spread the Lord's word to the youth during these unprecedented times.
